

Environmental Policy Statement



Go Plant Limited recognises the importance of environmental protection and is committed to operating its business responsibly and in compliance with all legal requirements relating to the aspects specific to commercial and residential environmental cleansing and waste management services. It is the business' policy to meet its ISO 14001 obligations and commit to and maintain good relations with all regulatory bodies.

Our business objective is to carry out all measures with a commitment to meet, exceed or develop all necessary requirements, to prevent pollution and to continually improve environmental performance through the implementation of the following:

- Assess and regularly re-assess the environmental effects of the Organisation's activities;
- Training of employees in environmental issues;
- Minimise the production of waste;
- Minimise material wastage;
- Minimise energy and water wastage;
- Promote the use of recyclable and renewable materials;
- Reduce and/or limit the production of pollutants to water, land and air;
- Control noise and dust emissions from operations;
- Minimise the risk to the general public and employees from operations and activities undertaken by the Organisation.

This Policy is communicated to all employees, suppliers and sub-contractors and is made available to the public.

Our Business Environmental Policy is based upon the following principles:

- To seek opportunities to continually improve the environmental management system;
- To comply with, and exceed where practicable, all applicable legislation, regulations and codes of practice;
- To integrate sustainability considerations into all our business decisions;
- To ensure that all staff are fully aware of our Environmental Policy and are committed to implementing and improving it;
- To minimise the impact on sustainability of all office and transportation activities;
- To make customers and suppliers aware of our Policy, and encourage them to adopt sound sustainable management practices;
- To review, annually report, and to continually strive to improve our environmental performance.

In consequence, the Company will pursue the following sustainability programs of action:

- We will endeavour to reduce the amount of municipal waste sent to landfill. Identifying measures, using modern technology and improving processes to enhance the reuse and recycling of road sweepings where possible.
- We will monitor use of energy and maximise efficiency with which it is used. This includes eliminating unnecessary energy use, pursuing a program of energy conservation and reviewing water usage. We will implement measures that will allow us to move towards a carbon-neutral operation.
- We will regularly monitor and review, wherever practicable, the acquisition, use and disposal of materials. When materials and equipment are purchased, preference will be given to items produced in ways which cause least harm to the environment and which generate fewest waste materials. Other things being equal, preference will be given to suppliers in the region so as to promote local links with the community and to minimise travel distance for the delivery of goods.
- Where distribution of information on printed paper is essential, the Business will seek to make the most efficient use of the paper. We are also seeking to develop non-paper based methods of distribution information.
- We will promote general environmental awareness and education within our Company.
- We will endeavour to assess every major new initiative for its environmental costs and benefits.
- Costs and benefits in both environmental and financial terms will be considered when specific action deriving from this policy is proposed.
- We will monitor environmental performance to demonstrate continuous improvement.
